Notes from the meeting of 28th January 2009

Roads:

Two salt bins have been replaced. A request was made for a salt bin to be placed at the Bailey Lane End of Saunders Way.

The Clerk is to approach the Highways again regarding cleaning the roads, filling in potholes and the situation at Napple House.

Footpaths:

The footpath notice board has been cleaned, and the map and photos will be replaced. The Herefordshire Footpath Officer has stated that a team is being formed to reinstate the footpath and stile where the landslide occurred near the Summer House.

Planning:

The planning application at The Cider House at New Town has been withdrawn. The application submitted by Cobrey Farms was not approved. Hopes Ash Farm are going to apply for conversion of a stone barn into accommodation for a farm worker to replace the caravan currently opposite the farm.

Two trailer tents have appeared at The Rocks to join the caravan. The Council intends speaking to the landowner to ascertain what he intends to do there.

The Clerk will write a letter of support for the installation of a wind turbine at Great Howle Farm – a planning appeal was being held on 17th February.
