Roads:

The Chairman welcomed District Councillor Harry Bramer, who attended the meeting, and Councillor Bramer stated that road cleaning and repair may be a long term project in the area due to current financial constraints.

The track at Bailey Lane End will be resurfaced at parishioner's expense, even though the refuse lorry uses it.

Footpaths:

Five new footpath gates have been delivered, and will be put in place in the parish by Councillor Freeman.

Daffodils:

The purchase of daffodil bulbs for planting on verges was not agreed, but individuals are welcome to plant as they wish.

Planning:

The Council support the application for an extension at Oak Tree Cottage, Dancing Green.

“Rave”:

Concern was raised over the level of noise played until 3am at the “rave” held on Howle Hill in August. Several parishioners had telephoned the police and the duty Environmental Officer at Hereford Council to complain.
