Notes from the meeting of 18th November 2009

Roads:

The Chairman has purchased a sack of daffodils, planted half on the triangle at the top of the village, and given the other half to BLE. A dangerous bough at the top of Harechurch is actually in Gloucestershire, but the Chairman will have it removed. The clerk is writing to Hereford Council about the fallen leaves and mud on the roads, and will suggest that if Hereford do not have the equipment available, Hope Mansell will arrange a private contractor at Hereford Highways expense.

Footpaths:

Two new gates have now been erected in the Parish, and other work is being surveyed.

Howle Hill 'Rave':

The clerk is to ask Hereford Council if neighbouring parishes could be informed of any licence application for a similar event in the future.

Fireworks:

Someone has been letting fireworks off from the viewpoint between 10 and 10.30pm, annoying neighbours and frightening horses. The police have been notified and will monitor the problem.

Post box:

Royal Mail have decided that the post box in the centre of Hope Mansell will not be replaced due to the small amount of mail collected from it before it was stolen.

Planning:

The planning application for Cuckoo Patch was rejected. An application for a garden implement store, with water and sewerage at The Cottage (above Lily Cottage), Bailey Brook was referred to the Planning Officer to make a decision.
