Notes from the meeting of 8th September

Roads: The number and locations of saltbins in the Parish is unsatisfactory. Filling efficiency should be reviewed; too many bins are left empty and too many are left overflowing. A request will be made for 3 or 4 bins on Bartwood Lane. There is concern about Harechurch, and the overgrowth of trees, which could be brought down if we suffer another snowy winter.

Amey have offered to send a representative to discuss issues with councillors, and the clerk will arrange dates

Dancing Green oak tree: To apply for a Tree Preservation Order a letter will be sent to Mr T Bolton stating the reasons for protecting the tree, and the tree will be inspected.

Council Elections: Notification has been sent from Herefordshire Council of local council elections on 5th May 2011.

Footpaths: Mr Gardiner (County Footpaths Officer) will be approached about the possibility of installing gates at the end of the 'Rocky Lane' and the path at Flock Cottages.
