### **Notes from the meeting of 10th November 2010**

#### **Roads:**

The problem of large lorries from Cowbray Farm and the lack of passing places was discussed, with a letter of support from Walford Parish Council.

Amey have suggested a date in February to complete a parish walk to assess work to be done. The Council felt it should be sooner.

Damage was done to a reflector post and concrete pillar at Bailey Lane End at the cattle grid, which is not in good condition. The Highways will be told.

#### **Sandbags:**

#### **Queen's Diamond Jubilee:**

#### **Planning:**

An application for a garden implement store, with water and sewerage at The Cottage (above Lily Cottage), Bailey Brook was approved in part. The Council have written to the planning officer to object to the planning appeal regarding the siting of a caravan at Horn Hill Cottage.
