Notes from the meeting of 12th January 2011

Binbags:

There is an issue with black binbags, which were not distributed (last October) to residents of Dancing Green, down to Newtown, and quite patchily elsewhere.

Planning:

No planning was discussed. (Just after the meeting the Council became aware that the planning appeal regarding the siting of a mobile home at Horn Hill Cottage for tourism purposes has been turned down).

Roads:

Amey will be walking the parish roads with the Parish Council on Monday 7th February at 10am, starting at Parkfields, to assess the work that is needed. The (leaking) well up Bartwood Lane was half dug up last summer and barriers erected using sandbags, which have been blocking the passing place ever since. Another issue for Amey.

The 40mph sign in BLE has been knocked down and needs re-erecting.

The Clerk will be contacting the Forestry Commission and Amey about repairing the cattle grid/post at Bailey Lane End.

There is concern about the road at Belbridge Kennels towards Drybrook, which is badly breaking up. Unfortunately this is in Gloucestershire, and the Parish Council will look into contacting their Highways Department.

Dancing Green Oak Tree:

The Clerk is pressing ahead with the attempt to have a preservation order applied to this tree.
