Site Meetings with Hereford Council

A site meeting was recently made with the Chairman representing the Parish Council to determine if a mirror could be installed near Hoovers Lane to assist better visibility and safety for road users. A further site meeting will take place in the next few weeks to review road conditions in the Parish.

School Flashing Warning Lights

The Chairman and Councillor Catherine Chinn are working with the school to determine how these warning lights for motorists can again be made functional and controlled during the key periods needed. Site inspections have also taken place by the Highways Authority to replace fuses and check that they can work properly.

The meeting thanked Council Members for co-ordinating duties at the Village Hall and Pontshill and in particular to all Parish residents and their families who came and collected the litter. In all 20 groups took part to help keep our Parish clean and tidy. It is planned to repeat this activity again next year.
