Coleraine Farm. Re-site agricultural worker's dwellings. This application is on the border with Walford Parish Council who have arranged for a public meeting at Walford Village Hall on 21 November 08 at 7.30 pm for the opinions of all Parish residents.  
Bollitree Castle. Remove stable and replace with 5 car garages.

#### **Bus Shelters**

The Parish Council own 4 bus shelters in the Parish. Council members carry out regular checks on them for the state of their maintenance and organise repairs as necessary.

#### **Affordable Housing Workshop**
